Vote at your convenience by internet, telephone, or paper ballot!

Each eligible and registered elector on the Voters' List will receive, by mail, a "Voter Information Letter" in the month of September.

This letter will contain a Personal Identification Number (PIN) which will allow you to vote 24 hours a day from Monday, October 19th at 10:00 a.m. until Monday, October 26th at 8:00 p.m., from any telephone or any device connected to the internet.

As an added security feature, you will be required to add your date of birth before voting. If you are unsure that your full date of birth is on the Voters' List, you may contact the Municipal Office to have it added prior to voting.

Is it Possible to Receive More Than One PIN?

YES. If you receive more than one PIN it is because your name appears on the Voters' List more than once. This rare situation may occur if you changed your place of residence, or if you own more than one property in the municipality and are incorrectly registered as a resident at both locations.

You are permitted by law to vote **ONCE** in any municipality either as a resident or non-resident voter.

If you receive more than one Voter Information Letter for the Municipal Election in the Village of Merrickville-Wolford, please notify the Municipal Office. Any additional PINS will need to be cancelled rendering them unusable for the Election.

If You Don't Receive a Letter

If you do not receive a Voter Information Letter by October 14, 2026, please contact the Municipal Office. You may need to be added to the Voters' List.

Who May Vote?

Any person who, on October 26, 2026 (Voting Day), meets all of the following qualifications is eligible to vote:

1. A resident of the Village of Merrickville-Wolford, or an owner or tenant of land, or the spouse of such an owner or tenant.
2. A Canadian citizen.
3. At least 18 years old as of October 26, 2026 (Voting Day).
4. Not prohibited from voting by law.

Are you on the Voter's List?

If you are NOT on the Voters' List or the recorded information about you is incorrect, you will need to complete Form EL15 to amend the Voters List. You will require proof of identification or proof of qualification as an elector. Please contact the Municipality to ask how to submit the form.
